1	50th Anniversary Funding	
1.1	AW advised that Bill Bell had confirmed any funding for the 50 th Anniversary event has to come from the Accuracy Panel funds, and there would be no further funding from the BHPA available for this event.	
1.2	It was noted that the deficit in the budget prepared by ME would be made up from sponsorship money. It was agreed that everyone should seek sponsorship.	All
1.3	It was agreed that the Accuracy Panel would fund the FAI registrations, the PGAEC registration and PGAWC registration. Andy Shaw to provide paperwork to Jonathan Parkinson to claim the costs	AS
1.4	A vote was carried out on the following two funding options: 1. The BHPA Accuracy panel will fund the FAI registrations, the PGAEC registration and PGAWC and then Green Dragons Airsports take on the risk of the events - 2 votes. 2. The BHPA Accuracy panel will take on the risk of the events up to a cap of £6,000 and any further risk is taken on by Green Dragons Airsports. The £6,000 includes the registration fees above - 3 votes. Option 2 was therefore carried.	
1.5	It was felt that pilot entry fees should be paid into an account organised by Green Dragons Airsports to maintain an expenditure cash flow. Green Dragons Airsports to set up a pilot payment system in conjunction with Airtribune. Green Dragons Airsports will maintain auditable accounts of income and expenditure. After the final round the accounts will be finalised to determine any loss and further payment by the Accuracy Panel.	GDA GDA
